

# Plan your weekend travel

There are no planned track works on the Tube this weekend. However, the following stations and lines will be affected by engineering and improvement works.

## Circle line Station closure

**Ladbroke Grove:** closed Sunday and Monday for the Notting Hill Carnival.

## Hammersmith & City line Station closure

**Ladbroke Grove:** closed Sunday and Monday for the Notting Hill Carnival.

## London Overground Part closure

### Richmond/Clapham Junction to Stratford route

**Sunday:** no service between Clapham Junction and Willesden Junction until 11am owing to Network Rail track work. Use local buses via any reasonable route.

### Watford Junction to Euston route

**All weekend:** no service between Watford Junction and Euston owing to Network Rail track improvement, and work at Euston to enable High Speed Two. Replacement buses will run:

Service H: Watford Junction – Watford High Street – Bushey – Carpenders Park – Hatch End – Headstone Lane – Harrow & Wealdstone.

Use Bakerloo line services between Harrow & Wealdstone and Queen's Park. Use local buses or London Underground services between Queen's Park and Euston via all reasonable routes (entrance/exit at Queen's Park, Kilburn Park, Euston Square and Euston stations).

### Gospel Oak to Barking route

**Saturday (until 7pm):** no service between South Tottenham and Barking while Network Rail carries out works to enable new, longer trains to run from 2018. Replacement buses will run:

Service T: Walthamstow Central (for the Victoria line) – Leyton Midland Road – Leytonstone High Road (bus stops at Harrow Green) – Wanstead Park – Woodgrange Park – East Ham (for the District and Hammersmith & City lines) – Barking.

At East Ham, eastbound buses set down only, westbound buses pick up only.

Use local buses between South Tottenham and Walthamstow Queen's Road or London Underground services between Finsbury Park and Walthamstow Central, and between East Ham and Barking.

**Saturday (after 7pm) and Sunday (until 3.30pm):** no service between Gospel Oak and Barking while Network Rail carries out works to enable new, longer trains to run from 2018. Replacement bus services will run.

Service J: Gospel Oak (bus stops in Highgate Road) – Upper Holloway – Crouch Hill (bus stops in Hornsey Road) – Finsbury Park (Tube) – Harringay Green Lanes – Seven Sisters (for the Victoria line and South Tottenham).

Service T: Walthamstow Central (for the Victoria line) – Leyton Midland Road – Leytonstone High Road (bus stops at Harrow Green) – Wanstead Park – Woodgrange Park – East Ham (for the District and Hammersmith & City lines) (station not served on Sunday due to local road closures) – Barking.

At East Ham, eastbound buses set down only, westbound buses pick up only.

Use local buses between South Tottenham and Walthamstow Queen's Road or London Underground services between Finsbury Park and Walthamstow Central, and between East Ham and Barking.

### Romford to Upminster route

**Sunday and Monday:** no service between Romford and Upminster owing to Crossrail construction work and Network Rail infrastructure work. Use local bus services instead.

### Liverpool Street to Enfield Town/Cheshunt (via Seven Sisters)/Chingford route

**Tuesday to Thursday:** no service between Hackney Downs and Chingford after 10.30pm owing to Network Rail track work. Replacement buses will run.

## TfL Rail Full closure

**Sunday and Monday:** no service on the entire line owing to Network Rail track and station improvements, and Crossrail construction work. Replacement bus services will run:

Stratford – Forest Gate – Manor Park – Ilford – Seven Kings – Goodmayes – Chadwell Heath – Romford.

Newbury Park (for the Central line) – Chadwell Heath – Romford – Gidea Park – Harold Wood – Brentwood – Shenfield.

## Docklands Light Railway Part closure

**Sunday and Monday:** no service between Stratford and Bow Church owing to Crossrail works at Pudding Mill Lane. Use local buses via all reasonable routes.

## London Trams Part closure

**Until Sunday, September 3:** no service between New Addington and Lloyd Park from 10.30pm tonight owing to track renewal work. Replacement buses will run between New Addington and East Croydon via Gravel Hill, calling at:

Parkway – Lodge Lane – Addington Village – Kent Gate Way – Gravel Hill – Coombe Lane – Coombe Road – Park Hill Road – Addiscombe Road, George Street (East) – Dingwall Road.



## Going to Carnival?

NOTTING Hill Carnival returns to west London this weekend.

With the area closed to traffic, the easiest way to get there is by bus or Tube, walking or cycling.

### By Tube

Some stations near to the event will be exit-only and will close early.

### Nearest stations

Holland Park – will be exit-only from 7pm on Sunday and Monday.

Latimer Road – closed from 11.30pm on Sunday and Monday.

Notting Hill Gate – exit-only between 11am and 7pm. Circle and District line trains will not stop between 11am and 7pm on Sunday and Monday.

Royal Oak – exit-only between 11am and 6pm.

Closed from 6pm on Sunday and Monday.

Westbourne Park – exit-only between 11am and 6pm. Closed from 11.30pm on both days.

Some stations may close temporarily if they become overcrowded.

### By bus

Road closures will mean some bus routes will be diverted or terminate earlier, and may be busier than usual.

**Bus routes affected include:** 7, 16, 18, 23, 27, 28, 31, 46, 52, 70, 94, 98, 148, 220, 228, 295, 316, 328, 332, 390, 414, 452, N7, N16, N18, N28, N31, N98 and N207.

Extra buses will run on routes 2, 36, 205 and 436.

## Travelling via Euston this bank holiday?

EUSTON mainline station will be closed to rail services this August bank holiday weekend.

No trains will run tomorrow or Sunday while work to prepare the line for High Speed Two is

carried out.

While the station is closed there will be no London

Overground service between Euston and Watford Junction.

Passengers are advised to use

the replacement bus service, local buses or the Bakerloo line to reach their destination.

Euston Tube station will remain open with services running as normal.
