Strike update

At the time of going to press, members of the ASLEF and RMT unions plan to strike on Tuesday April 2 – from midnight to midnight.

If this takes place, it is expected that there will be no Jubilee line services between Wembley Park and Stanmore. There would also be a reduced service between Wembley Park and Stratford (every four to six minutes during peak times, as opposed to every two minutes). Tube tickets will be valid on local buses.

Passengers are advised to avoid the Jubilee line, particularly at large

interchanges including London Bridge, Waterloo and Stratford, and to use alternative routes where possible.

Anyone attending concerts at the O2 should allow more time for their journey and consider using the Emirates Air Line to travel between Greenwich Peninsula and Royal Docks and change to the Docklands Light Railway at Royal Victoria.

There are no planned works on the Bakerloo, Central, Hammersmith & City, Piccadilly, Victoria or Waterloo & City lines, or London Overground. However, the following stations and lines will be affected by engineering and improvement work.

Circle line Part closure

Monday: No service between Aldgate and Gloucester Road via Victoria. This is while new trains are tested and preparation work for the installation of a new signalling system takes place. Use alternative Tube lines and/or local buses.

Farringdon: Closed from Friday to Monday while preparations for roof refurbishment work takes place. Use nearby Barbican and King's Cross St. Pancras stations.

District line Part closure

Monday: No service between Aldgate East and Earl's Court while new trains are tested and preparation works for the installation of a new signalling system takes place. Use alternative Tube lines and/or local buses.

Hammersmith & City line Station closure

Farringdon: See Circle line entry.

Jubilee line Part closure

Friday-Monday: No service between West Hampstead and Stanmore while track is replaced and improved on the Jubilee line, and the adjacent Metropolitan line. Replacement buses will run:

Service A: Stonebridge Park (for the Bakerloo line) – Wembley Park – Kingsbury – Queensbury – Canons Park – Stanmore

Service B: Finchley Road – West Hampstead – Kilburn – Willesden Green – Dollis Hill – Neasden – Wembley Park

Metropolitan line Part closure

Friday-Monday: No service between Aldgate and Uxbridge/Rickmansworth/Croxley while track is replaced and new drainage is installed at Neasden, Pinner and Northwood. Train services will operate between Amersham/Chesham and Watford via Rickmansworth and Croxley. Replacement buses will run.

Service A: Rickmansworth – Ruislip – West Ruislip (for the Central line)

Service B: Wembley Park – Preston Road – Kenton (for the Bakerloo line) – Northwick Park – Harrow-on-the-Hill – West Harrow – North Harrow – Pinner – Northwood Hills – Northwood – Rickmansworth

Service C: Kenton (for the Bakerloo line) – Harrow-on-the-Hill – West Harrow – North Harrow – Rayners Lane

Service D: Northwood – Moor Park

There will be no Chiltern Railways service between Marylebone and Amersham.

Farringdon: See Circle line entry.

Northern line Part closure

Friday-Monday: No service between Kennington and Edgware via Bank. This will enable progress to be made installing a new signalling system – part of a comprehensive improvement of the line. Replacement buses will run:

Service D: Finchley Road (for southbound Jubilee line services) – Golders Green – Hendon Central – Colindale – Burnt Oak – Edgware

Service E: Camden Town – Chalk Farm – Belsize Park – Hampstead – Golders Green – Brent Cross (station and shopping centre) – Hendon Central

Waterloo & City line Enhanced service

Friday-Monday: Services will run for longer, from 8am to 10pm (10am to 8pm on Sunday), to provide an alternative route via the City.

Docklands Light Railway Part closure

Friday-Monday: No service between Canning Town and Beckton owing to Crossrail work at Custom House. Replacement buses will run:

Service A: Canning Town – Custom House for ExCeL – Prince Regent – Royal Albert – Beckton Park – Cyprus – Gallions Reach – Beckton (every seven to ten minutes from 5.30am to 1.30am the next morning on Friday, Saturday and Monday, and from 6.30am to half past midnight on Sunday)

Service E: Canning Town – Royal Victoria (for Emirates Air Line) – Custom House for ExCeL (every ten minutes from 5.30am to 1.30am the next morning on Friday, Saturday and Monday, and from 8.30am to 8.30pm on Sunday)

London Tramlink Part closure

Sunday: No service between Sandilands and New Addington owing to works. Trams from Wimbledon will terminate at East Croydon. Trams will run normally to Elmers End and Beckenham Junction. Replacement buses will call at all stops between East Croydon and New Addington except Lebanon Road and Sandilands which are served by Lines 1 and 2. (Elmers End and Beckenham Junction). Tickets will be accepted on local buses. Oyster pay as you go customers will receive a refund if they touch in correctly when boarding or changing from tram to bus.
