

# Plan your weekend travel

Apart from the Metropolitan line, there are no engineering works on the rest of the Underground this weekend. There are also no planned works on London Trams. However, engineering and improvement works will affect the following services:

## Metropolitan line

### Part closure

**Sunday:** no service between Wembley Park and Aldgate before 9.30am and after 8.30pm, owing to track replacement work. Use Jubilee line services between Wembley Park and Baker Street or the Circle or Hammersmith & City lines between Baker Street and Aldgate instead.

## London Overground

### Part closure

#### Richmond/Clapham Junction to Stratford route

**Saturday:** no service between Camden Road and Stratford, owing to bridge replacement works at Highbury Corner. Rail replacement buses will run:

- Camden Road – Holloway Road (for Piccadilly line) – Highbury & Islington – Canonbury – Dalston Junction – Hackney Central – Homerton – Hackney Wick – Stratford

**Sunday:** no service between Gospel Oak and Stratford, owing to bridge replacement work at Highbury Corner and Network Rail infrastructure work. Replacement buses will run:

- Hampstead Heath – Gospel Oak (Aginccourt Road/Southampton Road) – Camden Road – Holloway Road (for Piccadilly line) – Highbury & Islington – Canonbury – Dalston Junction – Hackney Central – Homerton – Hackney Wick – Stratford

For Caledonian Road and Barnsbury, use local bus route 274 to/from Camden Road or walk to/from Highbury & Islington.

#### Highbury & Islington to New Cross/Clapham Junction/Crystal Palace/West Croydon route

**All weekend:** no service between Highbury & Islington and Dalston Junction, owing to bridge replacement works at Highbury Corner. Replacement buses will run between Highbury & Islington, Canonbury and Dalston Junction.

**Sunday:** no service between Surrey Quays and Clapham Junction. Replacement buses will run: Canada Water – Surrey Quays – Queens Road Peckham – Peckham Rye – Denmark Hill – Clapham High Street – Wandsworth Road – Clapham Junction

#### Liverpool Street to Enfield Town/Cheshunt (via Seven Sisters)/Chingford route

**All weekend:** no services between Hackney Downs and Chingford, owing to Network Rail track work. Replacement buses will run:

- Hackney Downs – Clapton – St James Street – Walthamstow Central – Wood Street – Highams Park – Chingford

Use London Underground connections between Liverpool Street, Seven Sisters, Tottenham Hale and Walthamstow Central or local buses via any reasonable route.

**Monday to Thursday:** no service between Hackney Downs and Chingford after 10.30pm, owing to Network Rail track work. Replacement bus services will run.

#### Romford to Upminster route

**All weekend:** no service between Romford and Upminster, owing to Crossrail construction work. Use local bus route 370.

## TfL Rail

### Part closure

**All weekend:** no service between Stratford and Shenfield. Use the Central line between Stratford and Newbury Park. Replacement buses will run:

- Stratford City – Forest Gate (Romford Road) – Manor Park (Romford Road) – Ilford – Seven Kings – Goodmayes – Chadwell Heath (Wangey Road) – Romford
- Newbury Park (for Central line) – Chadwell Heath (Wangey Road) – Romford – Gidea Park – Harold Wood – Brentwood – Shenfield

## DLR

### Part closure

**All weekend:** no service between Bank and Shadwell, owing to improvement work at Bank station. The following amended services will run:

- Tower Gateway – Lewisham; Tower Gateway – Beckton; Stratford – Canary Wharf; Poplar – Woolwich Arsenal; Stratford International – Woolwich Arsenal

## No Northern line at Bank

NORTHERN line services will not stop at Bank station this weekend while improvement works take place.

Customers for Bank should exit at Moorgate station, which is about a ten-minute walk away. Alternatively, leave at London Bridge station and use local bus routes 21, 43, 133, 141 or N133.

## Upgrade works at Tottenham Hale

THIS Saturday, construction work will take place outside Tottenham Hale Tube station as part of TfL's plan to modernise the Tube.

The station will remain open as normal, with lift and escalator service all weekend.

However, between 7am and 7pm on Saturday there will be no ramp access

to or from the ticket hall. On Sunday the station will open as normal, with full step-free access.
