3795 The Minutes of the Board Meeting held on the 2nd April 1925 were confirmed and signed.

3796 Traffic position

The Chairman discussed the question of traffic receipts in relation to the proposed action of certain independent omnibus Owners with regard to reduction of fares, and in the withdrawal of their Representative from the London and Home Counties Traffic Advisory Committee. Having further discussed the traffic position generally he recommended that the Companies concerned take no action in regard to the proposed reduction of fares at present, and unless and until the situation developed unfavourably.

It was resolved to approve so far as this Company is concerned.

3797 Provisional Monthly Results

The Comptroller & Accountant submitted statement showing the Provisional Monthly Results for the three months to the 31st March 1925,

compared with the corresponding period of the previous year, which was received.

3798 Cash Statements

Also reported in regard to Accidents and Claims that the position continued to show improvement. To the end of April fatal accidents had decreased 24% in total and 32% per 100,000 car miles run, while expenditure in connection with accidents generally had decreased 17% in total and 27% per 100,000 car miles run, that for the same period 20 claims cases had been contested in the Courts, the Companies being successful in all cases save two.
